Washington FBLA NLC Policy:

For the 2019 National Leadership Conference, the NLC travel package is REQUIRED for anyone wishing to be endorsed as a competitor by Washington FBLA. The primary reason behind this policy is student safety.

WASHINGTON FBLA TRAVEL PACKAGE OVERVIEW

The Washington FBLA NLC 2019 Travel Package is a service of Washington FBLA, offered in order to maximize the NLC experience as a united state delegation. **The 2019 travel package is a LAND ONLY PACKAGE. Individual Chapters are responsible for their own air and ground transportation arrangements.**

Travel Package Includes:

- 6 nights lodging at Washington's official conference hotel – National FBLA has not yet announced our hotel assignment, only the expected rates and taxes.
- NLC Conference Registration & Insurance
- Your choice of the following:
 - State Day—which will include transportation to/from Six Flags, lunch at Six Flags, and a group state dinner at Hard Rock Café.
 - Institute for Leaders
- 10 state trading pins
- Spirit items for general session
- State dinner and activity night at Dave & Buster's
- Washington FBLA NLC Shirt and Drawstring Backpack

On-site NLC Coordination for the 2019 National Leadership Conference in San Antonio will be managed by Washington FBLA. Washington FBLA is not a travel agency. Because the package rate includes a set number of nights, no flexibility exists for deviation from this group conference package. Individual chapters are welcome to arrive early/stay beyond the timeframe of the conference, but all housing arrangements will be the responsibility of the individual chapter until the group arrival date. The **ONLY** way for Washington FBLA Members to be endorsed as competitors is to travel on the Washington FBLA Travel Package.

IMPORTANT WASHINGTON FBLA FACTS REGARDING NLC 2019

- All registration processes will be online using forms submitted through Wufoo. Links are available in this document and on our website.
- All Washington competitors are required to register through the state. The only way to compete as a Washington competitor is to register to use this package. There are no exceptions to this policy.
- Washington FBLA will register you for conference with the National Center. **DO NOT register online** at the national website, as you will be responsible for payment of any additional fees that result in duplicate registrations.
- Advisers will be assigned NLC duties by National FBLA. These could be on June 28, 29, or 30.
- Lodging for students will first be grouped by chapter. However, in order to make the quad rooming arrangement, students may be paired with other members from across the state.
- It is crucial that you meet all deadlines. Unlike with other events this year where Washington has had the flexibility to extend our internal deadlines, all of these deadlines correlate with national deadlines and there is no flexibility. **NLC Deadlines are NOT suggestions.**

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INFORMATION ON COMPETITION & LEADERSHIP PROGRAM

- Intent to Compete Forms are due for every competitor placing 1-10th place. Please be sure to fill out intent to compete forms for all of your students who placed at any level in their events!
 - Intent to Compete Forms are due by **April 19 at 5:00 p.m.** Forms will be available online at <https://leadable.info/WAFBLA19NLCIntent>.
 - Intent to Compete Forms are to be completed online. Email, FAX, and U.S. Mail will not be accepted.
 - If Intent to Compete Forms are not received by April 19, then the competitor space for NLC may be released.
- NLC Travel Forms (One per Chapter and One per Traveler Forms) **MUST** be received by **April 29, 2019**, otherwise the NLC space may be released.

- If 50% deposits for NLC are not received by WA FBLA by **May 8**, the NLC space **MAY** be released.

WHERE NOT TO SEND MATERIALS

- Do not send required NLC materials to National FBLA.
- Do not send required NLC materials to your school district (unless your school district requires copies or additional district only forms).
- Do not send anything to Olympia, Union, Jacksonville, or Seattle. In fact, do not send anything (other than payment, which goes to Owasso, Oklahoma) as everything is online.
