Good morning, Advisers!

With SBLC growing closer we have some important time-sensitive information to share this week.

National Anthem Singer

If you have students interested in singing the National Anthem during the Opening Session of SBLC, please direct them to our document library under the Conferences heading to find the 2018 National Anthem Singer Audition Form (<https://trileadership.wufoo.com/forms/wa-fbla-sblc-2018-national-anthem-singer/>). The form opens for audition submissions on February 1. All submissions are due by midnight on **March 15**.

Role Play Events/Registration

Role Play Events are handling testing differently this year! Role Play testing is now open to region qualifying teams for SBLC. To test in a SBLC Role Play event, you must have been in the top 6 at your region conference, or be counted as one of your chapter's wild cards.

For SBLC, role play testing will happen separate of other testing. Registration is now open. Registration for Role Play Testing will close at 5 p.m. on February 13. Role Play testing will open as quickly as possible on February 14. Testing will close at 5 p.m. on February 26, and the top 15 in role play events will be announced on the morning of February 27.

Testing is \$5 per student who participates. If it is a team of 3, the total charge is \$15. There is no chapter overview form to complete.

Signing up for role play testing does not obligate a team to attend SBLC. If they are not in the top 15, they will not be eligible to compete in these events at SBLC.

If they are in the top 15, and they choose not to advance to SBLC, the number of teams presenting will be reduced - we will not bump up other teams.

There are no exceptions to the timeline for role play testing.

SBLC Housing

The SBLC Housing Form Download will be available soon on the SBLC page of our WA FBLA Web site. This form will need to be completed and uploaded through the Housing Submission Link on the same page. Conference attendees will have the choice of staying at either the Hyatt Bellevue (conference headquarters/competitive event location) or the Hilton Bellevue.

The Housing Submission Link opens at **3:30 p.m.** on **February 26, 2018**, and closes at **5 p.m.** on **March 2**. The form currently says “not ready yet” until the time it opens.
