NEW STEM Robotics 101 Intro PD Workshops Scheduled

The Statewide STEM Robotics 101 Professional Development Program is again being supported by FIRST Washington and the Olympia School District through the OSPI Computer Science Education Grant. This program includes a free/customizable curriculum, CTE Frameworks/LE's models, 12 STEM Clock Hours and a 5% below-market discount from LEGO. Follow-up 1-day workshops will also be offered throughout the 2018/19 school year for Intro PD graduates.
