## **SBLC ONLINE TESTING**

Login information is now available for advisers to retrieve for their students. An email was sent to all advisers from TFI Customer Service last week with adviser update information for access to student login cards for SBLC. Advisers will be able to access the login credentials for their students who are taking online objective tests. These same adviser credentials will be used after SBLC for you to see more information on the testing results.

The testing window is **April 5-15**. Please consider testing your students earlier rather than later. All tests must be completed by **5:00 p.m. on April 15**. If any of you have questions or issues getting your login credentials, please let me know.

## **SBLC TEAM OBJECTIVE TESTING**

Where collaborative objective tests are concerned, teams will take tests individually and FBLA will average the scores of the team members.

- If a registered team member(s) does not log in and take the test, the scores of only the remaining team member(s) will be averaged
- The team member(s) who did not take the test forfeit their eligibility for the remainder of the event; they will be dropped from the team and will not be allowed to continue in competition for that event.
