On behalf of Washington FBLA, Washington TSA, and all of our students—we are PUMPED to see you tomorrow—LIVE and in 3D in Yakima for our first ever LeaderCon Live experience! The day will be very fast paced, action packed, and full of leadership lessons for your students to take home. This is the first fully live and in person event for WA FBLA in nearly two years – and it has been two years too many!

Please note the following:

- The only registration materials we will be providing are name badges. Our goal is to make the “stop” at registration as quick as possible. We will have a limited number of printed agendas throughout our space – but we encourage you to either print the attached or send it to your students to have on their devices.
- We are not providing paper or writing utensils. Students should come with a device (with enough power for the entire experience) to take notes, or, bring their own paper & pencil.
- The dress code for attendees is **SCHOOL APPROPRIATE CASUAL**—with the encouragement for students to wear chapter T-shirts if you have them, or previous conference T-shirts.
- We are following all health and safety guidelines—this means that indoors, masks will be required at all times when not actively eating or drinking. We want to continue to be able to hold live events—please remind your students and any adult travelers of the



importance of following this guidance—meaning a mask must fully cover both nose and mouth—at all times. No requirements for vaccination or testing is required of participants for this event.

- Lunch will be served buffet—all students will be required to sanitize their hands before entering the buffet line.

Registration will open at 10 a.m. in the Yakima Convention Center Lobby. The event will begin promptly at 10:30 a.m. We encourage you to pick up name badges and head directly into the ballroom and find seats when you arrive.
