WILD CARDS INCREASED

Due to the continuing Covid situation, we are increasing our Wild Card allotment for all chapters from two to FIVE! This gives those students who were registered for WLC but couldn't participate in their regional conference due to health-related situations the opportunity to advance to SBLC.

This year for the 2022 SBLC each chapter will receive five (5) Wild Card entries. Your chapter may enter five events at state that are beyond your eligibility; i.e., if you have no region winners in an event, or you want to enter more than 2 in a straight-to-state event. This is 5 entries, not 5 people, so it could be 5 team events.

SBLC JUDGES

With our State Business Leadership Conference just around the corner, we'd like to ask you to take a moment today to reach out to your network and encourage them to volunteer as a judge! This year we will need over 150 judges on Thursday and Friday of SBLC to evaluate competitive events. We appreciate your help in reaching out to your students' parents, colleagues, friends, chaperones, and family to invite them to sign up as a volunteer judge. ROLE PLAY TESTING REGISTRATION

Role play registration is now open in Blue Panda! To test in a SBLC Role Play event, you must have been in the top 6 at your region conference, or be counted as one of your chapter's wild cards.

There will be a \$5 charge per test, and will show on your invoice when your registration has been submitted.

The testing window will be open from February 21, 2022 to March 1, 2022, and your testing information will be sent to you directly from TFI, the online testing administrator.



Signing up for role play testing does not obligate a team to attend SBLC. If they are not in the top 15 of the test results, they will not be eligible to compete in these events at SBLC. If they are in the top 15, and they choose not to advance to SBLC, the number of teams presenting will be reduced—we will not bump up other teams.

There are no exceptions to the timeline for role play testing.
