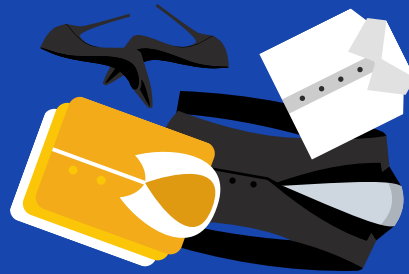

REGION RUMBLE

When you're not preparing for your competitive event, there's another competition you can participate in: the **Region Rumble Fundraiser**! Join forces with members from your region to find out who can raise the most money to support the March of Dimes at SBLC.

Each region will have their own bank, and to gain points, members can **add pennies and bills** to their respective region's bank. To subtract points from other regions, **add silver coins** to other region's banks.

The region with the most points by April 26th will be crowned the **State Champion of Region Rumble** for the 2023 – 2024 year and receive a plaque for the regional adviser to display in their classroom.

Pennies, \$1, \$5, and \$10 bills will **add** 1, 100, 500, and 1000 points respectively. Nickels, dimes, and quarters will **subtract** 5, 10, and 25 points respectively.
